These cards are designed to help your child identify the beginning short vowel sound in words. There are 3 pictures provided for each vowel.

Print the sheets, cut and then laminate to make them more sturdy for younger children.

Match the pictures to their beginning vowel sound. You can also use the picture cards to practice identifying objects with your child.

E - easel, eagle, earrings

U - utensils, uniform, unicycle
