A great go-along book for preschoolers is <u>The Wizard of Oz</u>, retold by Carol Ottolenghi.


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
















## Word Matching


Draw lines to match the correct words to the pictures.




Tin Man

Cut out the puzzle pieces for your child to put together. You can make the puzzle gradually more difficult each day by first cutting it into four strips, then into 8 pieces and eventually into the full 20 pieces.



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Cut out and tape together the two strips to make one long patterning board. Use the images on the previous to work on different patterns with your child!


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Print, laminate and cut out. Have your child either clip a clothespin to the correct beginning letter sound or use a dry erase marker to circle the correct letter.



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
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
